1. The leather surface of the Leatherlam contains 100% post-industrial recycled fibers resulting in an overall recycle content greater than 20%.
2. The inks used to produce the leather are water based and heavy metal free.
3. Leather is manufactured at our Morristown, TN facility which is ISO 9001 Certified.

### LEED Information – Leatherlam

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#### MR Credit 4.1 Recycled Content:

The leather fibers used in the production of the leather surface are 100 post industrial recycled. The final laminate sheets including paper and leather fibers with resin is greater then 20% post industrial recycled.

No Urea-Formaldehyde Resins are used in the production of the laminate.
